Dear Professor Deelder,

I am writing to you in my capacity as President of the British Society of Parasitology about this year's Spring Meeting held at Reading University, March 23rd-25th. Although the scientific aspects of the meeting were well organised, everyone, myself included, was most upset at the poor quality of the social facilities provided by this University which were much below the standard our members expect to have at our Spring Meetings. In fact, our Meetings Secretary has had a number of letters of protest and others on the Executive have had many verbal protests from members. Our Secretary, Dr. Hominick, took the matter up with the Vice Chancellor of Reading University who has sent the Society a letter of apology and has promised to investigate the more outrageous incidents that occurred.

I have decided to write to you and others from outside the U.K. who were present at this meeting to say how sorry we are that you were subjected to this. The Society particularly values and welcomes the presence and participation of our friends and colleagues from abroad and all U.K. members would be very sad indeed if the less than satisfactory aspects of the meeting at Reading so affected you that you decided not to join us at meetings in the future.

We need to make bookings for the venue of our Spring Meeting at least 3 years ahead which does make it difficult to be certain that all will be well when the time comes. The next meeting is at Southampton University from 20th-22nd March, 1989. We were advised that when the Universities were ranked in 1986 for the excellence of their facilities for conferences, Southampton was top of the list! We are therefore full of hope that our meeting at Southampton which will be a joint one with the Netherlands Society for Parasitology and Societe Belge de Parasitologie will be a particularly pleasant one.

Whether or not you are able to join us again next year, I do hope you will do so at some time in the future and that the less than pleasant aspects of the meeting this March will soon be a distant memory.
