Dear Sirs,

I acknowledge the receipt of the "Remarks in the matter of International Society of Parasitologists". I will give you the answers with some remarks to your questionnaire.

- 1) Jansen, Jacob Dr. (Med. Vet.)
- 2) Veterinary Parasitologist, Rubenslaan 59^{II}, Utrecht, Netherlands
- 3) I am in accordance with the project of creating the International Society of Parasitology.
- 4) No objections.
- 5) I propose as the seat of the Organising Committee the secretary's country.
- 6) I suggest to incorporate into the Organising Committee four or five noted parasitologists originating from the different continents of the world.
- 7) I propose to organise the first International Congress in the secretary's country in due time, for instance in the summer of 1962 or 1963.

I think it is necessary that the first International Congress should also give fair opportunities to discuss parasites, parasitism and parasitic diseases. Otherwise, I fear that to less specialists will be interested in this first Congress.

- 8) I am in accordance with the directive lines of the organisation, but I must point out that the members of the Organising Committee, for the sake of utility, should not be too numerous. Also for the same reason should the election of national representatives and secretaries not mean a national committee.
- 9) I am in accordance with the general purposes of the Society.
- 10) Unfortunately I am withdrawing from any duty in organising for the moment.
